Options:

- Should there be a well tuned (440 Hz) acoustic piano on site and if it is possibility to amplify it we might prefer using that!
- For smaller venues, or venues with limited equipment, things that can be taken out of the stage plot is:

A/ Skip the micing of the horn section (Henrik, Erik L., Albin, Sebastian)

B/ Go down to fewer monitor boxes and fewer monitor systems.

C/ Skip micing of Hurdy-gurdy, banjo, and second double bass channel, second channel of the fiddle, skip micing of the piano (if there's an acoustic piano on site), and skip some of the backup vocal mics.

• For VERY small venues with scarce equipment, we have done gigs acoustically, or with a few small amplifiers we bring ourselves.

Page 3 of 3 **Summary (what we need from the venue):**

Approx.:

- 24 channel mixer
- Approx. 24x xlr cables
- 4-8x monitors on at least 4 separate systems
- 3x DI-boxes
- 4x vocal mics
- 2x instrument mics (CM3 or similar, for redundancy)
- 4x mic stands *with* boom
- 3x chairs *without* armrests but *with* backrests (preferably with adjustable height)
- Drinking water on or adjacent to the stage.

About dining and allergies:

- We are a band of **10** people in total.
- I person is vegan.
- **4 people** are vegetarians, and among these **I person** is allergic to fish.
- **5 people** eat everything, but among these **I person** is allergic to nuts, and **I person** is lactose intolerant.
